

What to Bring To ROCK2012

- Bible
- Camera
- **1 SUITCASE / BAG per person**
- Please bring cold weather clothes, such as a winter jacket.
- Extra money (For late night pizza orders at hotel and lunch Saturday & Sunday. And if you plan to go to the outlets on Saturday during free time.) **BE AWARE** that there is a kitchenette in each room with full refrigerator, oven and microwave. If you would like to bring something you could prepare for breakfast on your own or for snacks, feel free.
- Deodorant and other personal hygiene items.
- Any medications, including aspirin. (if taking a prescription medication and you would like an adult to hold it and help remind you, see Pastor Tom or Mrs. Cheryl the day we leave.)
- Good attitude.

- Don't leave any valuable laying around in the hotel room while we are at the conference.
- Don't show disrespect to anyone at the event, or your parents will be really bummed having to come all the down there to pick you up!
- Don't be late to the bus or any meeting.
- Don't be late for the designated curfew set by Pastor Tom.
